

We The Island Nation of People Assembly (Jamaicans) Declaration of Original, Permanent, Unalienable Rights of every Man and Woman

This 22 Day of August, 2025, be it enacted and made public notice, by the sound of our voice, We The Island Nation of Living and Peaceful People Assembly commonly called “Jamaicans”, hereby say, state and declare these self-evident and unalienable rights, to be permanent, fixed and paramount above all claims, rebutting all presumptions and assumptions ab initio, the right to:

1. Life, Freedom, Health and the Pursuit of Happiness;
2. Contract, or Not to Contract, which is Unlimited;
3. Declare void all contracts made under deception and/or void of full disclosure of it's nature and

full extent/disadvantages;

4. Earn a Living freely, by labor or exchange with society or individual. Labor is a natural force used to create value, and thereby not a creature of government and exempt from taxation, levy or unlawful taking without just compensation agreed upon or 10x it's original value if stolen and recovered by any means;

5. Travel in the Ordinary Course of one's Life and Business;

6. Privacy and Confidentiality, free from Unwarranted Invasion;

7. Own, and Hold Property, lawfully without Trespass;

8. Self Defense when threatened with Harm, Loss, or Deceit;

9. Due Process of Law, with Notice and Opportunity to Defend;

10. Be Presumed Innocent, suffering No Detention or Arrest, No Search or Seizure, without Reasonable Lawful Cause by evidence of harm or wrong;

11. Remain Silent when accused, to avoid Self-incrimination, void of benefit to the prosecution or accuser;

12. Equality in the eyes of the Law, and to Equal Representation;

13. Trial by Jury, being an Impartial Panel of one's Peers (The People);

14. Appeal in Law against Conviction or Sentence, or both;

15. Expose Knowledge necessary to one's Rights and Freedoms;
16. Peaceful Association, Assembly, Expression, and Protest;
17. Practice a Religion and to have Beliefs, of one's own choosing;
18. Love, and to Consensual Marriage or tradition, with Children, as a Family;
19. Security from Abuse, Persecution, Tyranny, and War;
20. Refuse to Kill or Harm under command, by reason of Conscience;
21. Live in Peace and be left alone when Law-Abiding;
22. Maintain all power, held in reserve, unexercised, including but not limited to;

- a. The power to vote or retain all powers that would have been forfeited by voting;
- b. The power to register or retain all powers that would have been forfeited by registering;
- c. The power of voluntarily paying taxes or retain all powers that would have been forfeited by voluntarily paying taxes;
- d. The power to be apart of a lawful tribunal or to reserve the right to be apart of a lawful tribunal;
- e. The power to peaceful assemble or retain all powers of peaceful assembly;
- f. The power to recover all lost power, property, items or value taken without consent, under false pretense, threat, duress or coercion by any person, man, woman, being, creature of law, agent, agency or

government.

Violation of any enumerated right, shall be punishable by a minimum fine of five million Jamaican dollars, regardless of status or rank in society, claimed immunity under color of law or political affiliation or governmental office.

IGNORANCE OF THE LAW IS NO EXCUSE.

INTENTIONAL HARM CARRIES THE WEIGHT OF CONVICTION MULTIPLIED BY TEN (10x).

FAILURE TO SATISFY A PENALTY, CONVICTION OR JUDGMENT SHALL BE GROUNDS FOR PUNISHMENT OF INCARCERATION OF TEN YEARS MINIMUM, MULTIPLIED BY TEN.

The voice and will of the people are hereby made public, by notice to all, by inherent right of free

speech, freedom of expression, and freedom to assembly and make contracts of all kinds. By our birthright, we say state and declare the protections and rights herein to be protected individually and collectively. All violators shall be held liable equally.

One People, One Assembly, One Voice!
